Subject: A “California Mission”

What you will learn: This is a beautiful old mission, with wonderful architecture, and a flowered pathway that Donna and I visited two years ago. The painting is a great study in light, shadow perspective, and includes unique blending techniques! If you thought *Step by Beautiful Step* was an exciting painting to do -- you will love this one!! Note: *Students can include or exclude lettering as shown in painting as well as choose to show visitors coming and going from the mission.* I know this will be a great painting experience for any one! **Jerry Yarnell**

Collection of Fees: If you plan to attend the workshop, return your application (page 3 of this document) and deposit of \$100.00. Classes have limited seating – do not delay!

Refunds: Our cancellation policy allows for return of 100% of deposit when *cancellation notice is given two weeks prior to class.* Any refund requests after the two-week time limit will be *charged 50% of deposit as cancellation fee,* and your balance will be returned within 10 days. *No refunds are given if cancellation notice is less than two **business days** before the workshop begins.*

Transportation, Food & Lodging: Students are responsible to arrange for all mentioned. Sleeping rooms are available at the Rancho Hilton Garden Inn, phone 909.481.1800. Rates are \$99 + tax (includes breakfast). Be sure to ask for Jerry Yarnell Studio Group Rate. **Rate is guaranteed until February 27, 2012; at that time rooms are returned to inventory and the guaranteed room rate may not be available.**

Art Supplies Needed: First, a word of advice from Jerry: *Fine Art techniques require Fine Art tools.* Often students appear at our classes with substandard quality supplies because they've selected last-minute items with little to no guidance from the retailer

who sold them art supplies. Then once in our workshops, students encounter difficulty in achieving Jerry's techniques using some of these same retailer brushes and supplies. If you know Jerry, you know that he will **never** sell you a brush or an art product unless he really feels you need the item in order to improve your skill level and technique. Now, having said that:

You will receive a confirmation letter with supply list along with a map to the workshop location at least one month before the workshop date. You must furnish your own supplies – however – for your convenience and to ensure you have the appropriate quality – **an extensive collection of brushes, paints, canvases, books, and art supplies will be available for purchase at the workshop.** You must provide your own easel (floor or table) and an 18x24 canvas. Canvases will be available for purchase at the class.

Jerry prefers working in acrylics. However, if you prefer working with oils, use water-miscible oils. Jerry and others are allergic to traditional oils.

The Yarnell Studio & School of Fine Art has a *full art supply store* available to you – at our Studio, in our on-site workshops, and also in our online store at www.yarnellschool.com. Jerry will have his new Dynasty Brush Sets available that he has tested and endorsed.
