Location and Date: July 12-13, 2012 (Thursday & Friday)

Cost for 2-day Workshop: \$195.00 per person (no 1-day spots available)

Class Time: The Studio opens at 8:00 a.m. for set-up. Jerry begins class at 9 a.m. (Lunch 11:30 – 12:30); class ends at approximately 3 p.m. each day.

Subject: “Pheasant in the Rough”

What you will learn:

This is a wonderful 16x20 horizontal snow scene nestled in a beautiful country setting – an abandoned cabin, old fence, tall weeds on a snow-covered day with a vividly colored pheasant nearby. This painting has an array of subjects and techniques that will encourage, challenge, and excite you – different brush techniques, value system, and color schemes. For those of you who have wanting to do wildlife in a native setting, this is the one you’re waiting to paint. See you at my studio! Jerry Yarnell

Collection of Fees: If you plan to attend the workshop, return your application (page 3 of this document) and deposit of \$100.00. Our studio is smaller than workshop space we acquire while on the road so these classes have limited seating – do not delay!

Refunds: Our cancellation policy allows for return of 100% of deposit when cancellation notice is given two weeks prior to class. Any refund requests after the two-week time limit will be charged 50% of deposit as cancellation fee, and your balance will be returned within 10 days. No refunds are given if cancellation notice is less than two **business days** before the workshop begins.

Transportation, Food & Lodging: Students are responsible to arrange for all mentioned. Sleeping rooms are available at various locations in Tulsa, nearby Owasso, and limited locations in Skiatook. A lodging list is available from the “Contact Us” page of our website. We offer a \$5 cash buffet for lunch which includes your sandwich, chips, dessert, drink, and normally extras (like stew or whatever Jerry feels like making that morning). You can also bring a lunch if you prefer.

Art Supplies Needed:

You will receive a confirmation letter with supply list along with a map to the workshop location at least one month before the workshop date. You must furnish your own supplies including a 16x20 canvas – however – for your convenience and to ensure you have the appropriate quality – **an extensive collection of brushes, paints, canvases, books, and art supplies will be available for purchase at the workshop.** Tables and easels will be furnished.

Jerry prefers working in acrylics. However, if you prefer working with oils, use water-miscible oils. Jerry and others are allergic to traditional oils.

Jerry will have his new Dynasty Brush Sets available that he has tested and endorsed.
